






What is Greening TVET?


Figure 1: UN's Sustainable Development Goals

Education for Sustainable Development and TVET

 The ESD concept was coined by UNESCO as a way to integrate the pillars of education with the common practices in promoting sustainable development.

ESD promotes a sense of both local and global responsibility

• TVET curriculum towards the "6R" principles of: Reuse, Reduce, Renew, Recycle, Repair and Rethink





TVET is heading towards sustainability




